Legal Basis and Purpose of Processing

The legal basis for processing personal data is the legitimate interest of CLIC Innovation Ltd.

The purposes of processing include:

- Development of services and operations
- Maintaining and activating stakeholder relationships
- Sending newsletters
- Organising events
- Conducting customer satisfaction surveys and other studies

Data Collected

The register may include:

- Basic information (name, role in organization, connection to CLIC Innovation)
- Contact details (email, phone)
- Employer company details from official registers
- Event participation data (including dietary restrictions and accessibility needs)

Sources of Data

Data is mainly collected directly from the data subject via phone, online, meetings, or similar means. Data may also be updated from public sources such as company websites and official registers.

Disclosure of Data

Data is processed internally and by subcontractors acting on behalf of CLIC Innovation.

Data is not regularly disclosed to third parties.

Event organisers may receive participant data for event-related purposes.

Data may be transferred outside the EU/EEA in compliance with data protection laws.

Data Protection and Retention

Data is stored securely using technical and organizational measures.

Only authorised personnel can access data.

Data is generally retained for up to 3 years after last interaction.

Dietary data is deleted immediately after events.

Rights of the Data Subject

You have the right to:

- Access your data
- Correct inaccurate data
- Request deletion
- Restrict processing
- Object to processing
- Object to direct marketing
- Withdraw consent where processing is based on consent
- Data portability (when applicable)

You may exercise your rights by contacting the person listed above.

If you believe your data has been processed unlawfully, you have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority (Data Protection Ombudsman in Finland).
